We work with many different health plans; however, recommend verification with your insurance provider that all the necessary referrals and authorizations have been obtained prior to your visit. Maintaining annual visits with the Center's team is an important factor in maintaining one's health and reducing overall health care costs.

340B PHARMACY PROVIDER FAQ

The Hemophilia and Thrombosis Treatment Center of Hawai'i at Kapi'olani Medical Center is a nationally accredited and federally funded program—which allows us to provide medication to patients directly. Standard treatment of hemophilia involves replacing the missing clotting factor. Any money received from medication purchases, go toward the Center's work to improve patient services and programs (including support groups, outreach and education).

WHAT IS A 340B FACTOR PROGRAM?

In an effort to help Hemophilia Treatment Centers (HTC) in the U.S. sustain themselves and provide better care for their patients, Congress created what is known as the 340B Program. This program is designed to reduce costs, which in turn helps the HTC build and develop more services and programs to support its patients. The Hemophilia and Thrombosis Treatment Center of Hawai'i at Kapi'olani Medical Center is one of these 340B Programs and strives to bring high quality, comprehensive care to patients and their families.

HOW DOES IT PROVIDE BETTER COMPREHENSIVE CARE FOR YOU?

Any income that the Center makes goes back into programs and services for patients. This includes expanding outreach clinic visits to neighbor islands, providing education to local schools, emergency rooms, hospitals and other community providers as well as maintaining and enhancing the comprehensive team care at the HTC for our patients.

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

Participating in the program is voluntary. Just call 808-983-8551 to sign up. If eligible, you can choose to participate and receive outstanding services by the Kapi'olani team as your 340B pharmacy provider. We will process your child's prescription and the medication will be delivered to your home. Like most homecare companies, there are no additional charges for infusion supplies or shipping.
